INTRODUCTION TO THE MINI CAMPAIGN

Thank you for your interest in this topic, and for download this campaign. These will be four missions arranged into a small campaign for DCS MiG-29A (9.12A) module (full fidelity, so not FC3 version).



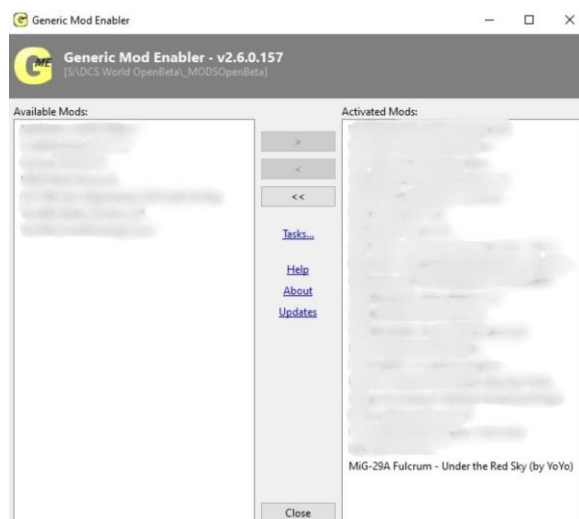
The campaign is set in late 1986, as winter descends on the Caucasus region. It tells about a short episode in the life of Senior Lieutenant **Dmitry Morozov**, a MiG-29 pilot. Although the Soviet Union is beginning to experience reforms under Mikhail Gorbachev's perestroika (restructuring) and glasnost (openness), these political changes have not yet reached the daily life of soldiers stationed on the southern frontier. For many stationed in remote or militarized regions such as the Caucasus, change came slowly. The Soviet military establishment, still shaped by decades of Cold War rivalry, remained focused on discipline and preparedness against perceived Western threats. The contrast between the promise of reform and the persistence of rigid military culture reflected the broader contradictions of the late Soviet era—an empire beginning to lose control over its vast territories while the idea of change began to take hold in people's minds. The principle of constant combat readiness in the air forces remained the same, especially since for several years now the Soviet Air Force had been using a modern fighter that could finally compete with the new generation of NATO aircraft that appeared in the first half of the 1980s.



INSTALLATION

1/ JSGME or OVGME

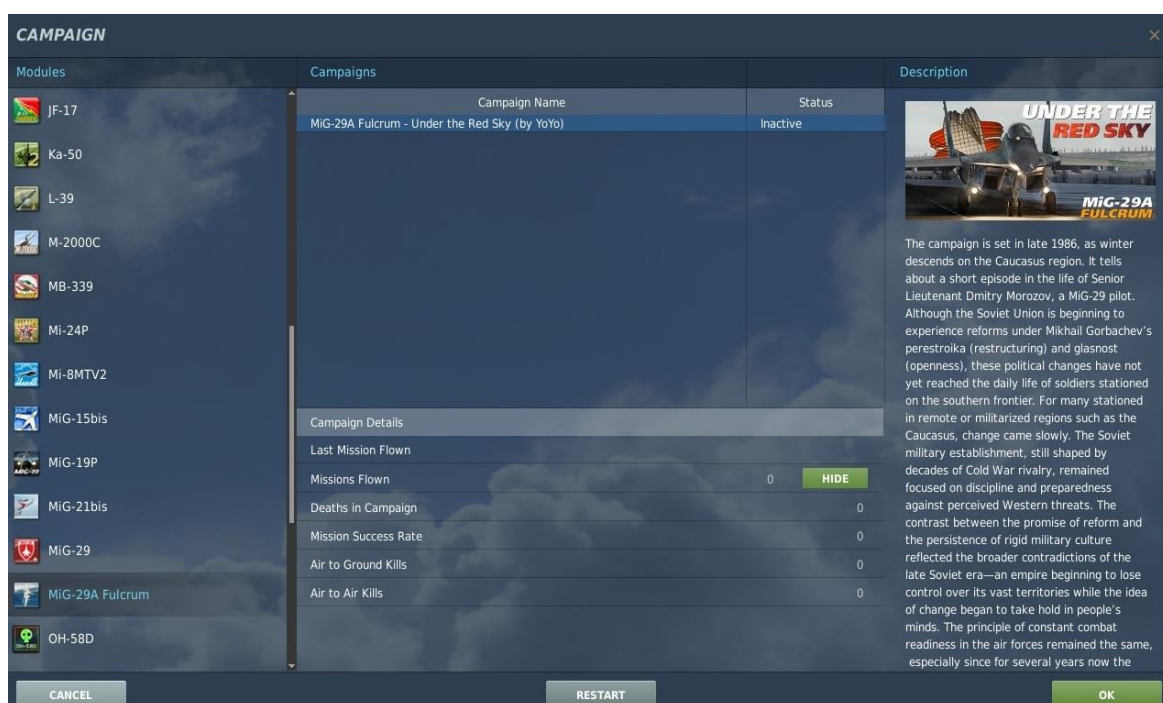
the best method is to install the mini campaign using JSGME or OVGME. Just put unpacked (from downloaded zip file) the main folder named „MiG-29A Fulcrum - Under the Red Sky (by YoYo)” in your “Mods” folder but of JSGME or OVGME and activate it via this software (example):



2/ Manual installation

If you prefer install it manually save the same structure which you will have in a zip file. Check what the folders look like and copy the contents of the zip file to your DCS in the same order (DCS World\Mods\campaigns\...).

In both cases the campaign should be visible in the campaigns section, in this case for the MiG-29A Fulcrum as in the attached image:



IMPORTANT THINGS TO PAY ATTENTION TO

- The campaign is designed for the metric system (in both communication and briefings). It's best to use the Russian cockpit + metric system.
- A fairly good knowledge and operation of navigation in the MiG-29A is required (including precision, IFR landings, course setting, knowledge of avionics, etc.).
- Fly along waypoints (according to the task), if you have to fly to a specific waypoint, fly over it, don't take "shortcuts" (for example from waypoint 1 to 3, skipping 2) because you might miss something. Cross waypoint directly.
- The campaign includes the USSR skin for the Tu-95MS, which will be installed along with everything else.
- It's also worth using the Bartheke's Caucasus textures mod (Caucasus Redone 2022) - winter looks much better, link for the topic about it: [click](#).
- If possible, use the autopilot for longer flights (but remember that it does not follow the waypoints on its own!).
- Save fuel; flying constantly at high RPM or with afterburner always will quickly end your flight, and you'll likely fail the mission. Prefer a constant speed of around 700-800 km/h and an RPM of 75-80%. This will give you almost 2 hours of flight time with the external tank.
- Read the briefing, your tasks and user tips that are displayed during the mission.
- You cannot destroy or damage the plane during the mission.
- You don't need to rearm, refuel or add anything. The aircraft is already prepared for its specific mission.
- Have fun! 😊
