MISSION 7 – OLD AND NEW

MISSION OVERVIEW

Tomorrow the Stennis Battle Group will transit the Strait of Hormuz and take up operations in the Persian Gulf proper. In preparation for this passage, coalition forces need to neutralize Iranian threats at Bandar Abbas.

Today we will launch an Alpha Strike against IIRAF aircraft and facilities at the Bandar Abbas airport.

WEATHER

A high-pressure system continues to remain in place over the AO, which will give us VFR conditions for the next 24hours. Conditions will be, throughout the area, scattered clouds and visibility 15+ miles in haze. Winds in general will be moderate from the south east. Temperatures will climb swiftly to the daytime high of 42 degrees Celsius.

PLAN OF ATTACK

At 01:40 Zulu, all flights will push from their assigned holds and run into their IPs. UZI 1 will target the southernmost set of QRA hangars on the north west side of the airfield. UZI 11's target is the eastern block (Target 1), while UZI 12 will target the pair just to the west (Target 2). See attached recon images for targets.

UZI 3 (F-18) and FRIEND 7 (UAE M2000C) flight will target any aircraft on the military ramp at the airport (northern end), while UZI 2 will provide SEAD cover.

CURRENT 7 (CF-18) and DUDE (F-14) flights will provide escort duties for both UZI flights.

THREATS

Iranian air defense networks are on a heightened state of alert, although they have been degraded over the last several days.

SURFACE TO AIR

Iranian naval units continue to operate close to Iranian territorial waters. Some of these vessels have surface to air capability, mainly the navalized SA-8 and SA-15 variants.

The SA-2 site at Qeshm Island is still active, despite last night's action, and will continue to pose a threat.

The HAWK site at Bandar Abbas has been naturalized, but indications of an active SA-6 site on the airfield have been noted. UZI 2 is directed to take out any SA-6 radars prior to UZI and FRIEND being overhead the airfield.

Intense radar and visually guided AAA is to be expected in and around the airfield and port of Bandar Abbas, along with MANPAD and SA-19 SAM units.

AIR TO AIR

The IIRAF has taken a beating over the two weeks, but remains a potent threat to coalition operations. Multiple F-4E CAP flights are operating from Bandar Abbas, while F-14's from Shiraz are patrolling the area.

COMMAND AND CONTROL

WIZARD will provide AEWC on button 13 to all elements of the package. All communications will be secure. Maintain radio discipline.

TANKERS

ARCO 11 (KC-135) will be available for all flights (317.4, TACAN 55x) if fuel is required post-strike. The orbit will be east to west, 10 miles south of Khasab Airbase.

There will be no AAR prior to the push.

ARCO 91, an S-3B, will be orbiting MOTHER at 6000 ft if emergency fuel is required on at the ship. They will be on 298.5, TACAN 31Y.

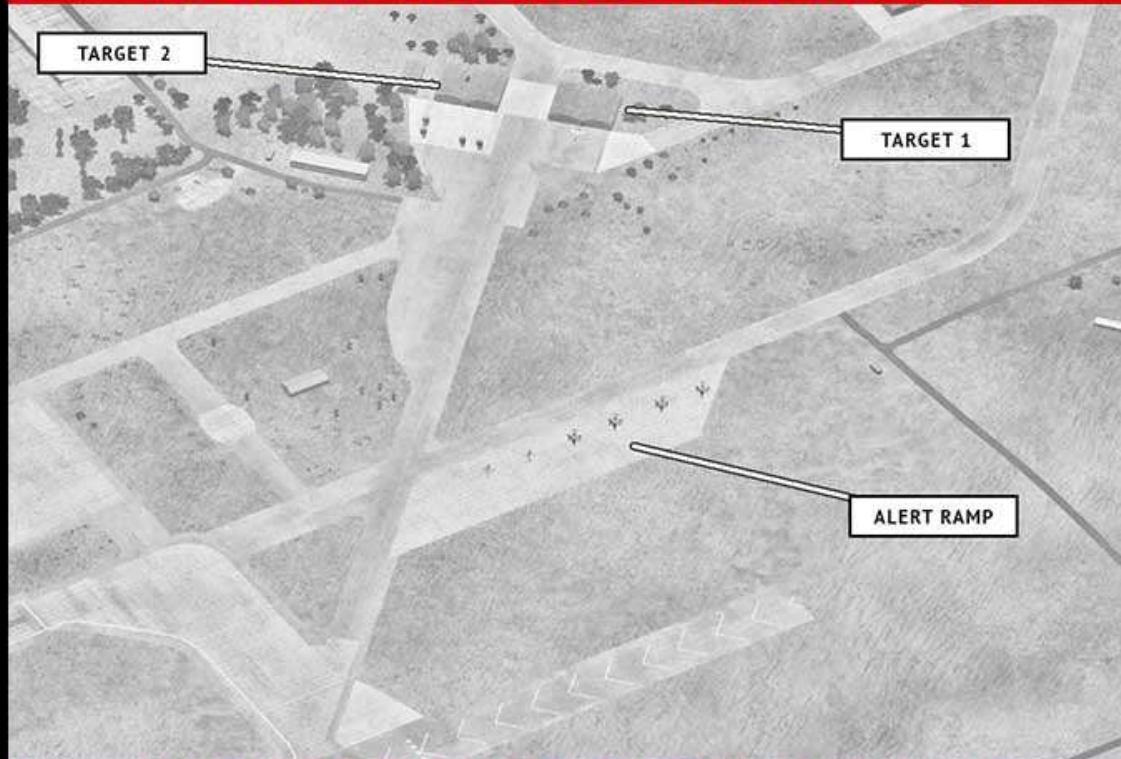
BOMB SUPPLY SITUATION

The Stennis weapons magazines are becoming depleted, and we are running critically low on 2000lb class guided bombs. As a result, some aircraft on today's strike will be using unguided 2000lb MK-84s.

Those pilots assigned MK-84s should use a 30 degree diving attack from 24,000, release by 15,000 and pull out by 10,000 to avoid the possible MANPAD or SA-19 threat.

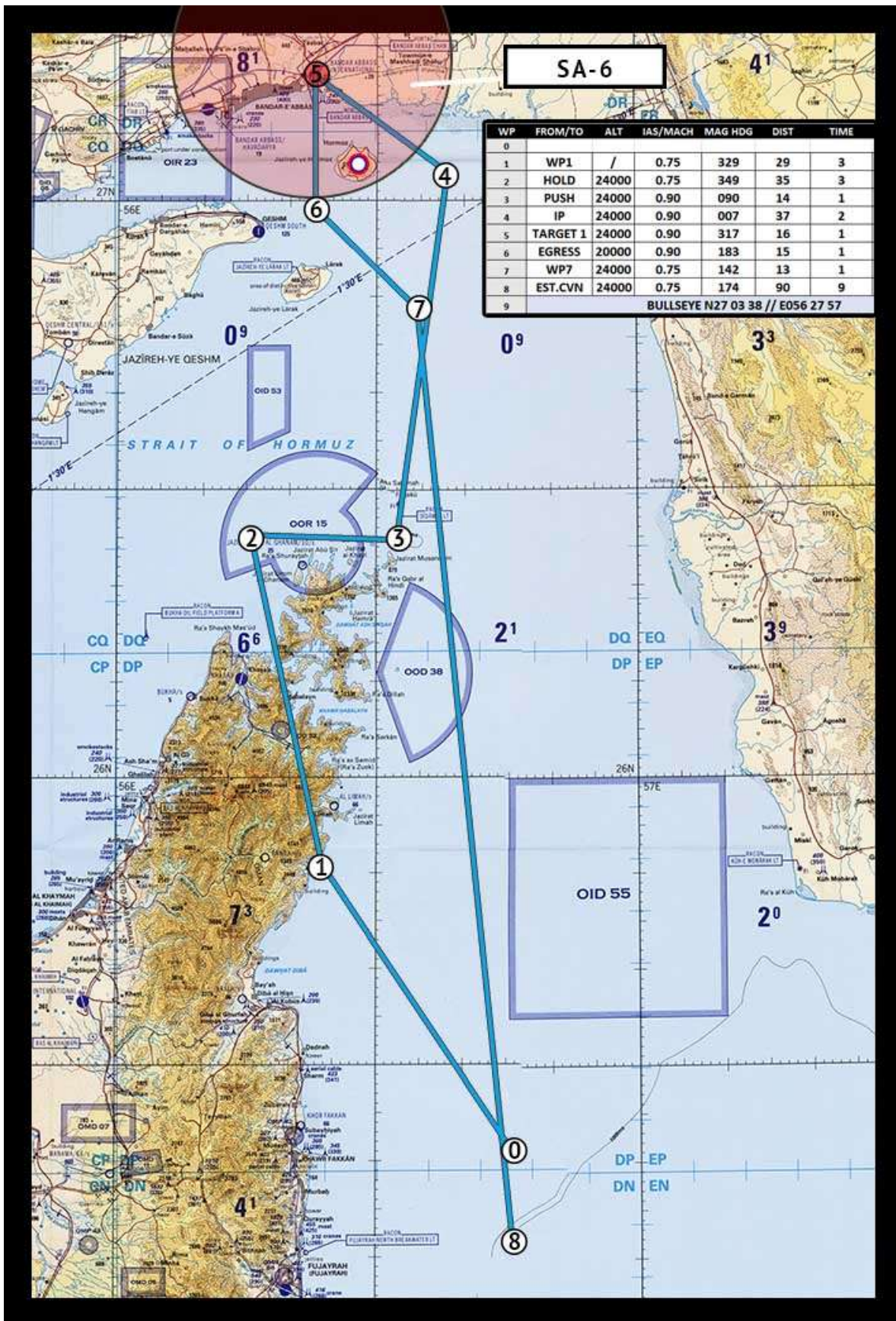
We are expecting a VERTREP evolution to happen later today, which should bring our magazines back up to a healthy capacity.
