[0] Notes for SCP-HAW member

[IMPORTANT] Mods required for missions are CIVILIAN Objects and Vechiles mod and the SCP MOD 1 (This is inside the campaign folder and needs to be dragged into saved/dcs/Mods/tech. It will show up as Utility_cargo (Do not worry about this).

[0.1] AI gunners should be on return fire unless engaged.

[0.2] SCP-HAW is designed to operate on a configuration of 1 ACH-47F, 1 OH-58D, 1 ARMED UH-60L. Deviating from this configuration may change level of operational ease. For some missions you need a sling loader and AGMs. Going solo would be... extremely hard but maybe could work with the KA-50-II which has sling loading and vikhrs. If someone manages to do that Post it on Youtube. I want to see it.

[0.3] In a case of deviating from normal operation configuration make sure GROUP and UNIT of SCP-HAW does not change. This might cause unexpected failures in the trigger system.

[0.4] Crank up your HELMET sounds for the best experience. The automated readings should be loud-ish.

[0.5] Don't scroll down to the known threats to avoid mission spoilers in briefing.

[0.6] Bringing Kevin along for the missions is not a necessity. But. Why not?

[0.7] Current release is with 3 hinds. Fly what you wish.

SCP FOUNDATION HEAVY AIRLIFT WING MANUAL

[1][Rules of engagement]:

[A]: Strategic mass-effect countermeasures, including classified mass-effect or area tools may be used.

[B]: High-yield measures that may cause substantial civilian and environmental damage are permitted to complete current objectives.

[C]: Conventional weapons and standard ordnance without higher clearance against clear, imminent threats to personnel or containment.

[D]: Non-lethal and containment-specific measures only, prioritizing capture and quarantine.

[E]: Weapons prohibited unless explicit authorization is granted by the SCP Urgent Instructions Hotline. Use de-escalation and evasion.

[2][Primary Classes]:

Class	Containment	Danger/Threat
[Safe]	Easily contained	Usually harmless if procedures followed
[Euclid]	Containment requires effort; unpredictable	Can be dangerous if containment fails
[Keter]	Extremely difficult to contain	High risk; often unpredictable and dangerous
[Thaumiel]	Used by Foundation to contain other SCPs	Generally not dangerous; helps control threats

[3][Crew Cognitive Safety Checklist]

[Short]:

[3.1]: Perform Pre-flight cognition test.

[3.2]: Any crew member showing confusion, déjà vu, or time loss must report.

[3.3]: Perceived hallucinations must be reported.

[4][Pre-flight cognitive test]

[4.1]: Phrase recall

In this recall test the Cognitive Assurance Officer (CAO) will call out various phrases and the Validated Aircrew Operator (VAO) must answer the calls correctly.

[4.2]: Repeated Phrase

CAO: "Six pawns walk the plank. "



VAO: [Repeats phrase]

[4.3]: Repeated phrase

CAO: "Glass fields do not burn."

VAO: [Repeats phrase]

[4.4]: Quick repetition (CAO can call out in any order)

CAO: "Up" → VAO: "Down"

CAO: "Down" → VAO: "Up"

CAO: "Right" → VAO: "Left"

CAO: "Left" → VAO: "Right"

[4.5]: Pattern recognition (For VAO)

Read the following patterns out loud

CAO: "Which one changed its orientation?"

VAO: "None. Orientation unchanged."

[4.6]:

If the VAO fails any of these tasks it must be reported immediately and the VAO must be quarantined/retired.

[5][Aircraft and crew protection protocols]:

[5.1]: Disable autopilot if anomaly causes magnetic interference.

[5.2]: Expect GPS drift in spatial distortion zones.

[5.3]: Switch to hard-wired flight instruments if interference suspected.

[5.4]: Do not discuss anomalous effects over communication channels unless absolutely necessary.

[5.5]: Maintain anomaly standoff distance: 500+ meters unless briefed otherwise.

[5.6]: Do NOT hover near memetic or auditory anomalies.

[5.7]: Avoid spotlights on unknown entities.

[5.9]: Rotate crew on sensory anomalies (eyes/ears) every 10 minutes. Time might vary

[5.10]: Log all visual distortions and out of ordinary events.

[5.11]: Do not ignore automated system warnings.
