

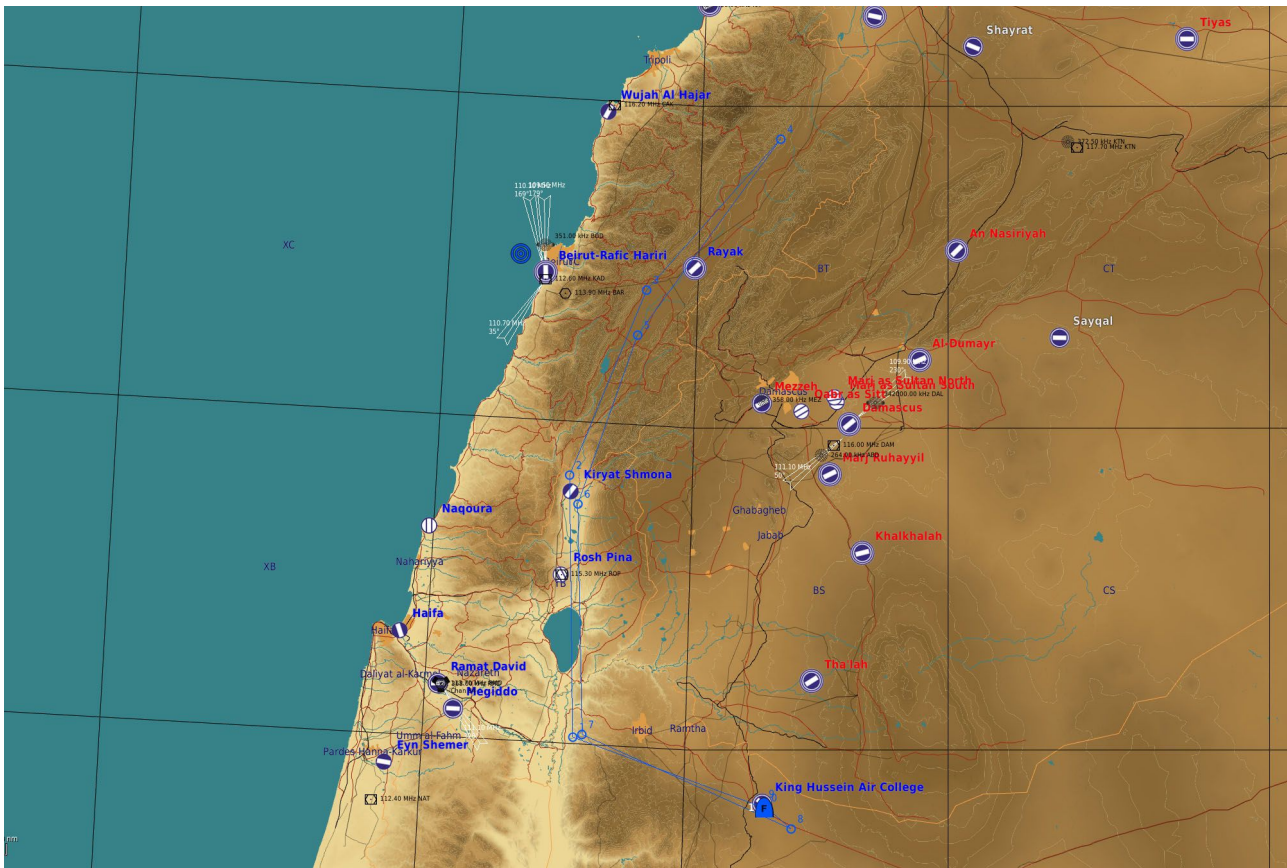


Mission 4, Hit the road

17th of March 1993

Syrian authorities officially protested for the loss of their MiG-25 ... but just lip service knowing that they broke international rules. Anyway, now the message is clear : French Air Force is able to counter threats on the ground or in the sky to protect Lebanon.



Briefing

Today you are tasked for a CAP. Just follow your flight plan and Brennos' orders. Intelligence service has identified no special threat. So you hope a quiet mission. But be careful, the situation can change without warning.

Mission starting at **16:30 pm**

WP1 450 kt / 15 000 ft
WP2-7 450 kt / 20 000 ft
WP8 300 kt / 5 000 ft
WP9 Mafrq Air Base

For approach and landing, use the standard F5 ATC radio menu !

This is a **cold** start.

To complete this mission you will need to follow Brennos instructions ... then land at Mafrag Air Base in good weather conditions and park your plane to the assigned location **(29)**.

Advice

- Respect the borders, use the passageway previously defined to go in and out Lebanon.
- You might need to register a new waypoint in your system. Be sure to know how to do that.
