

# ***MISSION 1 – Ferry flight***

***Rio Grande - 29/04/1982 - 09:15***



## **Situation**

29 April 1982

Following the establishment of BAM Malvinas in Puerto Argentino (Port Stanley) and BAM Condor in Goose Green, we are deploying a lot of aircrafts on the island: some 20 more Pucarás, a couple of Turbo Mentors and 4 Aermacchis.

## **Tasking**

We are transferring the second couple of MB-339As (4-A-115 and 4-a-116) in Puerto Argentino.

Since you're a bit rusted on the 339, you'll fly as backseater in 4-A-116. Your instructor, Pablo, will help you getting back to your A game.

You'll fly alongside 115 following a C-130, involved in the ongoing effort to bring equipment and materials on the islands, in a relaxed 3 ship formation.

Follow what your instructor says and you'll be there in no time.

Developer's notes:

- You will fly the mission from the backseat.
- The front seat pilot will start the plane through an autostart sequence. If you have the throttle cutoff binded to your joystick, leave the throttle in the off position until the autostart sequence moves the throttle to idle, at which point you should do the same.
- Parking brake, front anti-ice and fuel transfer are all automated through triggers. (it's normal to get an ice caution during cruise, you can disregard it)
- The mission is heavily scripted, thus it's very important to follow instructions. (i.e. entering the runway or landing without clearance)
- Mission time: 1h 40m
