

MISSION 4 – Battle for Goose Green

Puerto Argentino – 28/05/1982 – 12:15



Situation

28 May 1982

After landing in San Carlos, during the push through the island towards Puerto Argentino, the british troops deviated to capture Darwin and BAM Condor in Goose Green. Our troops, under the newly established task force Mercedes, formed by the 12th Infantry Regiment, part of the 25th Infantry Regiment, elements of the 4th Ariborne Artillery and the 601st Anti-Aircraft battalion, are currently holding them back at Darwin hill.

Tasking

We're sending all available planes to provide cover for our troops, it is of paramount importance to repel the attack and protect the airfield.

Today you'll be the leader of a three ship, you'll fly in 4-A-117, while your wingmans will be in 4-A-114 and 4-A-115.

Navigation is very easy today, just follow the coast south-west, enter the Choiseul sound heading west towards Darwin.

Our troops are entrenced in Darwin hill, enemy troops are coming from the north, but are very close by, be careful who you are shooting to!

Weather is far from ideal but should be improving during the day, we'll probably fly several missions today.

Developer's notes:

- Do not fly above 1.000 ft AGL to avoid detection
- Mission time: 30 min
