

# ***MISSION 5 – Battle for Goose Green***

***Puerto Argentino – 28/05/1982 – 16:30***



## **Situation**

28 May 1982

During the afternoon the british troops overran our positions at Darwin hill. We are now fighting the last stand at the airfield, we established an ongoing air bridge to supply the airfield with fresh troops through a couple of helicopters from Puerto Argentino, and we are sending more air support missions to reduce the pressure on the defenders. We can't lose the airfield!

## **Tasking**

After the failed attempt this morning the visibility improved, but high winds prevented us from taking off.

Just now the wind changed permitting take off, you'll lead again the same air support mission in 4-A-117. Unfortunately 4-A-115 could not be repaired, so you'll fly with only one wingman, Miguel, in 4-A-114.

Ingress route is the same as this morning, the british troops now overran our positions in Darwin and the fight moved south towards the airfield.

It will be hard to accurately hit their troops without risking another friendly fire incident, so your primary target will be the british artillery fire base just north of Darwin.

Developer's notes:

- Do not fly above 1.000 ft AGL to avoid detection
- Mission time: 30 min
