MISSION 6 – RESCUE

MISSION OVERVIEW

Last evening, DICE 11, an F-14B was shot down over Iran after it developed a navigation issue. The crew members were able to eject, but were separated on the ground. The backseater was taken prisoner shortly after the shootdown, but the pilot, DICE 11 Alpha was able to elude his pursuers and hole up for the night.

Unfortunately, the patrol that is perusing him is very close to finding him, so the rescue effort must begin right away.

UZI 1 flight is tasked to provide on call CAS support to the rescue effort.

WEATHER

A strong high-pressure system continues to remain in place over the AO, which will give us VFR conditions for the next 24-36 hours. Conditions will be, throughout the area, few clouds and visibility 15+ miles in haze. Winds in general will be light from the south east. Overnight temperatures will be in the mid 20's, rapidly increasing as the sun comes up to the expected high of 39 degrees.

OBJECTIVE

The objective is to rescue DICE 11 Alpha before the Iranians can take him into custody. The task force will fire BGM-109s to take out surface to air missile batteries north and south of the area prior to friendly arrival into Iranian airspace.

160th SOAR CH-47s, callsign Jolly 1 will infiltrate Iranian airspace to affect the rescue. UZI 1 and 2 flights will provide Close Air Support to the effort, while SWORD 8 will provide SEAD escort.

Dude 1 and 2 flight, F-14Bs, will provide RESCAP, while WIZARD will provide AEW control while COFFEE will be the airborne mission commander.

THREATS

Iranian air defense networks are on a heightened state of alert, although they have been degraded over the last several days.

SURFACE TO AIR

Iranian naval units continue to operate close to Iranian territorial waters. Some of these vessels have surface to air capability, mainly the navalized SA-8 and SA-15 variants.

There is an SA-2 site about 12 miles north of where DICE 11A is located. We are going to target this site with Tomahawk missiles a few minutes before the rescue package goes feet dry.

A HAWK site at Bandar Al Jask will also be targeted with a prestrike Tomahawk attack.

AIR TO AIR

The IIRAF has taken a beating over the two weeks, but remains a potent threat to coalition operations. Multiple F-4E CAP flights are operating from Bandar Abbas, while Bandar Al Jask is host to a squadron of F-5E fighters sitting alert 15 status.

COMMAND AND CONTROL

WIZARD will provide AEWC on button 13 to all elements of the package. All communications will be secure. Maintain radio discipline.

TANKERS

ARCO 11 (KC-130, 377.2, TACAN 51Y) will be available for UZI 1 and UZI 3 flights if fuel is required post-strike. There will be no AAR prior to the push.

There will be a tanker orbiting Mother at 6000ft for any issues getting aboard. Callsign ARCO 91, TACAN 31Y on 298.5.

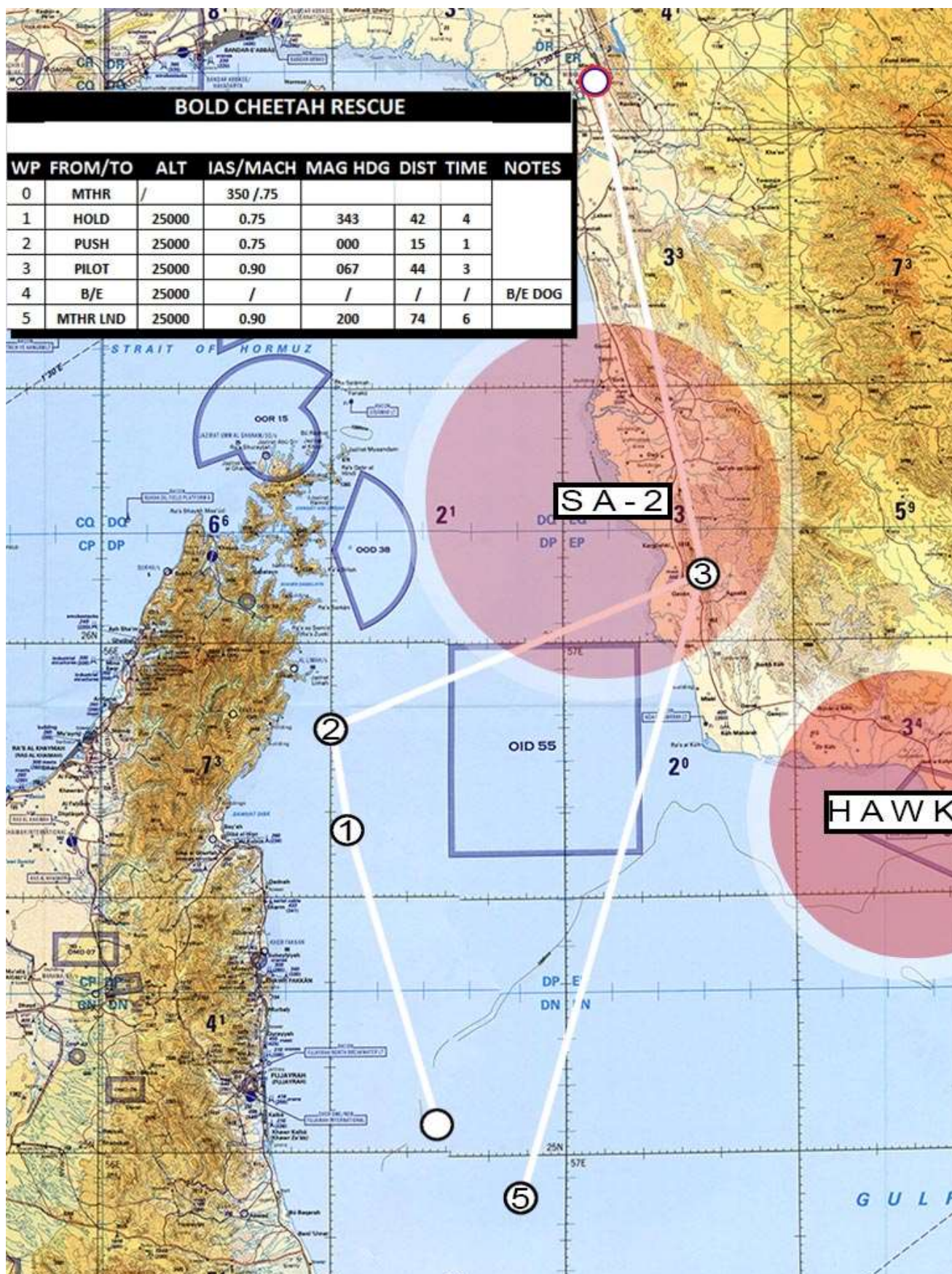
