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# MISSION 12 – ACTION, REACTION

## MISSION OVERVIEW

The defection of the MiG-29 pilot last night has set off a flurry of protests and threats from the Iranian government. They are now alleging that the UAE government has broken the non-aggression pact by allowing the defector to land at Khasab, and that a state of “limited hostilities” between the two countries now exists.

We are anticipating that the Iranians will launch an attack against Khasab within the next 12 hours, either by air or sea, or both.

Your mission is to provide a Combat Air Patrol overhead Khasab airfield, and defend it from any and all intruders.

## WEATHER

A strong high-pressure system continues to remain in place over the AO, which will give us VFR conditions for the next 24-36 hours. Conditions will be, throughout the area, few clouds and visibility 15+ miles in haze. Winds in general will be light from the south west. Overnight temperatures will be in the mid 20's, rapidly increasing as the sun comes up to the expected high of 39 degrees.

## **OBJECTIVE**

Defend Khasab airfield and Coalition airspace from any Iranian military forces.

UZI 1 will provide CAP overhead Khasab Airfield from 01:45Z-03:00Z, or until cleared off station via MAGIC control.

ROE Weapons Yellow, Weapons Hold. Do not fire unless fired upon or cleared to fire via MAGIC control.

## **THREATS**

Iranian air defense networks are on a heightened state of alert, although they have been degraded over the last several days.

### **SURFACE TO AIR**

Iranian naval units continue to operate close to Iranian territorial waters. Some of these vessels have surface to air capability, mainly the navalized SA-8 and SA-15 variants.

The SA-2 site on Qeshm Island is believed to be active again, stay clear.

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## **AIR TO AIR**

The IRIAF has taken a beating over the two weeks, but remains a potent threat to coalition operations. Multiple F-4E CAP flights are airborne constantly throughout the AO, mostly based at Bandar Abbas.

Iranian F-14s at Shiraz have been temporarily deployed to Bandar Abbas airfield and are currently sitting alert.

## **COMMAND AND CONTROL**

WIZARD will provide AEWG on button 13 to all elements of the package. All communications will be secure. Maintain radio discipline.

## **TANKERS**

ARCO 11 (KC-130) will be available for UZI 1 and UZI 3 flights if fuel is required post-strike. There will be no AAR prior to the push.

ARCO 91 (S-3B) is orbiting overhead MOTHER at 6000ft to provide emergency fuel to any aircraft having troubles getting aboard. They're TACAN 31Y and on 298.5.
