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(TS) **Task Organization:** United Army Delta Force Members, US Army 75<sup>th</sup> Ranger Regiment, 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion members, and USAF JSOC F-15E StrikeEagle pilots composing of approximately 85 enlisted and officer personnel will be identified with their respective Callsigns; 1-4 Bravo, Delta-1, and Hawg 1-1. All personnel will be tasked by the Ground Commander outlined in this order. Small arms, demolition, and heavy weapons are authorized for use in this mission. Close Air Support (CAS) will be on-station consisting of fixed wing assets. All coalition ground team members proficiency levels are expert. Additional Special Forces assets from the Coalition can be utilized if needed. Back-up forces from Forward Operation Bases (FOB)'s and Airbases in the region may be called upon by the Ground Commander if the situation dictates. Tactical dominance, air assault, ambush, and Military Operation in Urban Terrain (MOUT) will be vital to mission success.

**I. Situation**

(U) Security Council Committee pursuant to resolutions 1267 (1999) and 1989 (2011) concerning Al-Doran and associated individuals and entities:

(U) Al-Doran in Iraq was listed on **18 October 2004** pursuant to paragraphs 1 and 16 of resolution 1526 (2004) as being associated with Al-Doran for “participating in the financing, planning, facilitating, preparing or perpetrating of acts or activities by, in conjunction with, under the name of, on behalf or in support of”, “supplying, selling or transferring arms and related materiel to” or “otherwise supporting acts or activities of Abu-Mohammed Zeri and Al-Doran” (QE.A.4.01.).

(TS) Rebel and terrorist forces have occupied key cities within the Country of Georgia. Al-Doran, SPIA, and other key terrorist organizations have flocked to the region to regroup, retrain, and strategize to take over Europe and spread their Islamic ideals to the world. A small United Nations peacekeeping force was ordered into the country under Resolution 435.1 to establish a Secure Zone and No-Fly Zone in the southern and central region of Georgia. The UN forces under strict rules of engagement were quickly overtaken by the rebel and terrorist forces in the region, and were forced to retreat. Coalition Forces led by the United States are tasked in bringing order back to the region, eliminate the terrorist nexus, and Capture or Kill High Value Targets / War Criminals who have engulfed the region. Enemy resistance has been very strong, and Intelligence Reports suggest many of the rebel and terrorist groups are receiving financial and supply assistance from Iran, Syria, IIPR, and possibly senior members of other Middle Eastern countries.

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(TS) The Chairman Joint Chiefs of Staff has ordered the Capture mission for Al-Sheek Farrat, Codename: N/A. Signals Intelligence (SIGINT), and Human Intelligence (HUMINT) identified a possible location for Farrat inside the city of Bagdati. Farrat is the Commander in Bagdati for the Al-Doran terrorist organization. The operation is to capture Farrat alive to for further intelligence gathering in the AO. Farrat is suspected to be located at the heart of the city of Bagdati at grid coordinates; 38 T LM 20006 61085.

(TS) Bagdati is a major enemy controlled city with multiple enemy insurgents present. Heavy resistance is expected during operation.

### A. Enemy Forces

(U) 1. Weather conditions in the target area of operations (AO) are calm with high temperatures in the 90's. Cloud conditions are light to medium. Winds are calm at 1-2 kmh at ground level. Moonlight illumination is 1/2 strength within the next 24-48 hours.

(S) 2. Terrain: The target AO is a heavily urban city area. The area contains urban terrain and variable elevation. The area contains many high rise buildings, apartment buildings, and industrial buildings.

(S) 3. Identification of enemy forces: Al-Doran and Rebel forces will range from semi-skilled militia fighters in mixed military gear, to highly skilled infantry and anti-tank personnel with full body armor and light to heavy weapons. Anti-aircraft, armored assets, and motorized infantry units have been spotted at the target AO. Fixed wing Air Support for the enemy is not likely. However, rotary assets are possible.

(S) 4. Location(s): Enemy forces have been spotted by reconnaissance assets occupying Bagdati, and adjoining villages.

(S) 5. Activity: Enemy forces are occupying and defending the city at Bagdati. Morale is suspected to be high for the enemy force and surrender is not likely.

(S) 6. Strength: Exact strength of the enemy force is unknown. Expect squad and platoon size troop levels throughout the city. Enemy equipment ranges from anti-aircraft units, small arms, crew-served weapons, heavy machine guns, anti-tank weapons, and light armor. The enemy force is believed to have the capability to reinforce the village within 15 minutes with platoon to company size units.

(U) 7. Probable course(s) of action when the enemy is contacted is to Defend-and-Hold their established areas. Farrat may try to escape, watch for likely escape routes around the area. Suicide bombers may be present, and hidden IED's are likely to be present around the compound. Surrender is highly unlikely, enemy forces are highly trained and highly loyal to Farrat.

### B. Friendly Forces

(S) 1. Mission and concept of next higher unit:

(S) 1-4 Bravo (US Army, 75<sup>th</sup> Rangers, 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion, SF Unit): (Callsign: 1-4 Bravo) consisting of 4 x Chalks: 1 x Platoon Leader (with laser designator), 4 x Squad Leader, 35 x Operators, 8 x Grenadier, 8 x Medic, 10 x Support Gunner (optional sniper), 6 x Explosives Expert, 3 x MWD Team's (2 x HMMV Gun Trucks)

(S) Delta-1 (US Army, Delta Force, SF Unit): (Callsign: Delta-1)

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1 x Team Leader (with laser designator), 8 x Operators, 1-2 x Grenadier, 3 x Support Gunner (optional sniper), MWD Team, 2 x Combat Medic

(S) Delta-2 (US Army, Delta Force, SF Unit): (Callsign: Delta-2)

1 x Team Leader (with laser designator), 8 x Operators, 1-2 x Grenadier, 3 x Support Gunner (optional sniper), 2 x Combat Medic

(S) Hawg Flight (Close Air Support): (Callsign: Hawg 1-1)

4 x F-15E pilots (Hawg Flight) (Flight Lead): (Hawg 1-1)

(TS) 2. Location and planned actions of units; Delta-1 & 2 are tasked with the capture Al-Sheek Farrat. 1-4 Bravo are tasked with setting up a perimeter at the Target AO in the city of Bagdati. Units providing fire support as directed: Hawg Flight (CAS)

## **II. Mission**

(TS) The immediate Capture Al-Sheek Farrat. Captured enemy combatants will be relocated to FOB SUSE as enemy prisoners of war (EPW)'s. Search for intelligence at the enemy compound.

(S) 1-4 Bravo - Chalk-1 is responsible for securing the North sector of the Target AO.

(S) 1-4 Bravo - Chalk-2 is responsible for securing the East sector of the Target AO.

(S) 1-4 Bravo - Chalk-3 is responsible for securing the South sector of the Target AO.

(S) 1-4 Bravo - Chalk-4 is responsible for securing the West sector of the Target AO.

(S) 1-4 Bravo - Chalk-4 is responsible for deploying in 2 x HMMV gun trucks and securing the main roadway from the North and South at the Target AO.

(TS) Delta-1 & 2 are responsible for capturing Farrat at an enemy compound inside the city of Bagdati.

(S) Hawg Flight is responsible for CAS for ground forces.

(S) Mohawk-2 & 3 (2 x UH-60) are responsible for inserting 1-4 Bravo Chalk's 1-4 teams into the Target AO.

(S) Vulture-3 & 4 (2 x CH-47) are responsible inserting 1-4 Bravo Chalk-4 in 2 x HMMV gun trucks into the Target AO.

(S) Hellraiser-1 & 2 (2 x UH-1H) are responsible for inserting Delta-1 & 2 into the Target AO.

## **III. Execution**

### **Intent**

(TS) The immediate Capture Al-Sheek Farrat. Secondary: Search for intelligence at the enemy compound.

### **A. Concept of the Operation:**

(TS) The operation will be conducted at nighttime to assist with the element of surprise. All ground forces will be transported via designated helicopters from FOB Suse. Hellraiser-1 & 2 (2 x UH-60) will move out from FOB SUSE transporting Delta-1 and Delta-2 to a holding area NW of the Target AO. Mohawk-2 and Mohawk-3 will transport 1-4 Bravo – Chalk's 1-4 to the Target AO and land at LZ's established at the North and South portion of the Target AO. Vulture-2 and

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Vulture-3 (2 x CH-47) will move out from FOB Suse transporting 1-4 Bravo - Chalk-4 consisting of 2 x HMMV guntrucks and offload the troops and cargo East and West of the Target AO.

(TS) 1-4 Bravo will setup a defensive perimeter around the Target AO and engage forces as required. Once the defensive perimeter is established Hellraiser-1 and Hellraiser-2 will insert Delta-1 and Delta-2 North and South of the target building located at grid location; 38 T LM 20006 61085. Delta Force units will sweep and clear the designated buildings to capture Farrat.

(TS) Once Farrat is detained; friendly forces will sweep the target buildings for intelligence. Delta-1 will call for EXFIL of his forces and captured HVT's West of the Target AO along the main roadway. Hellraiser Flight will be tasked with EXFIL of Delta Forces and PAX.

(S) Hawg Flight will be available for On-Call CAS if required. Hawg Flight will patrol between WP2 (COP Moto) and WP3 (COP Eagles Nest) unless called into the Target AO by 1-4 Bravo.

(S) Once Delta teams have EXFIL'd, 1-4 Bravo teams will EXFIL back to FOB Suse via Mohawk and Vulture flights.

### **B. Tasks to Maneuver Units**

(S) Hellraiser Flight is tasked with any search and rescue or support for DURESS calls from friendly forces in the village. Always announce when crossing into another teams AOR or Sector to avoid friendly fire.

### **C. Tasks to Combat Support Units**

(S) CAS Flights (Hawg Flight) will patrol WP2 (COP Moto) and WP3 (COP Eagles Nest) unless called into the Target AO by 1-4 Bravo or other ground commanders.

### **D. Coordinating Instructions**

(S) Team leaders will coordinate what movement speed, type of formation, and rules of engagement for their respective members. Whiplash-1 and/or 1-4 Bravo Commander may dictate diversion in plans depending on the battlefield situation.

## **IV. Service Support**

(S) Whiplash-1 will task CSAR assets from FOB Suse with CASEVAC transport if required.

### **A. General**

(S) RV FOB Suse with CASEVAC patients.

### **B. Material and Services**

(S) Contact FOB Suse Command Post for supply needs.

### **C. Medical Evacuation:**

(S) Whiplash-1 will task FOB Suse forces with resupply drops and CASEVAC transport if required.

### **D. Personnel:**

(S) EPW's will be transported to FOB SUSE and held at the TIF Cropper.

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**E. Miscellaneous:**

(S) Special equipment. Biometrics scanner.

(S) Captured equipment. Any enemy equipment which is captured can be used or destroyed depending on mission needs.

**V. Command & Signal**

**A. Command**

(S) (Whiplash-1) has overall command of the region. 1-4 Bravo has operational command of this mission. Team leads for all enemy forces will command their teams to accomplish the mission.

**B. Signal**

(S) Main Communications will be portable and long range encrypted radio signals. Ground teams must meet with the COMSEC NCOIC to ensure CCI keys are current before mission start. (Will be present at airstrip on FOB SUSE)

(U) Loss of communications:

(S) Deploy WHITE smoke if in need of immediate help, with no communications. Closest friendly unit will backup team in duress. Inter-personal communications devices and manual hand and arm signals should be used by team for movements.



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
