### Mission Nine - "Comrades" Objectives:

- Follow your established flight path around the Area of Responsibility.
- Provide CAS to Ground Forces in the region if requested.
- Complete tasks as directed by the Operational Commander in the region (Whiplash-1).

22 September 2015 - Hawg Flight departed Kutaisi AB and began patrol operations in the AO. After Hawg Flight passed COP Moto and observed large and small arms fire at 38 T LM 69597 89897. Zulu-5, Georgian Army forces were being ambushed by Al-Doran enemy forces. Zulu-5 requested assistance from Hawg Flight. After positive authentication and approval from HQ; Hawg Flight engaged enemy forces at Zulu-5's location. Zulu-5 moved to a train station to setup a CASEVAC LZ. Enemy artillery and QRF forces attempted to mount an attack against Zulu-5. Hawg Flight neutralized the enemy forces endangering Zulu-5. Georgian CSAR assets successfully transported injured Georgian forces from the enemy controlled area. No further action or recommendations required. ///END OF REPORT///

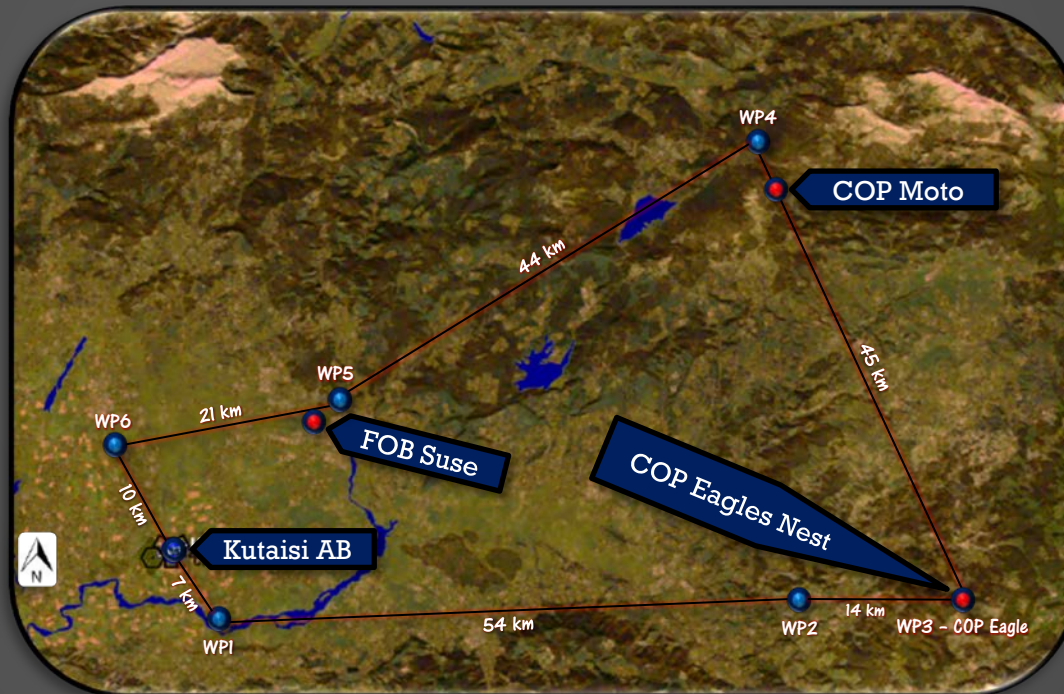

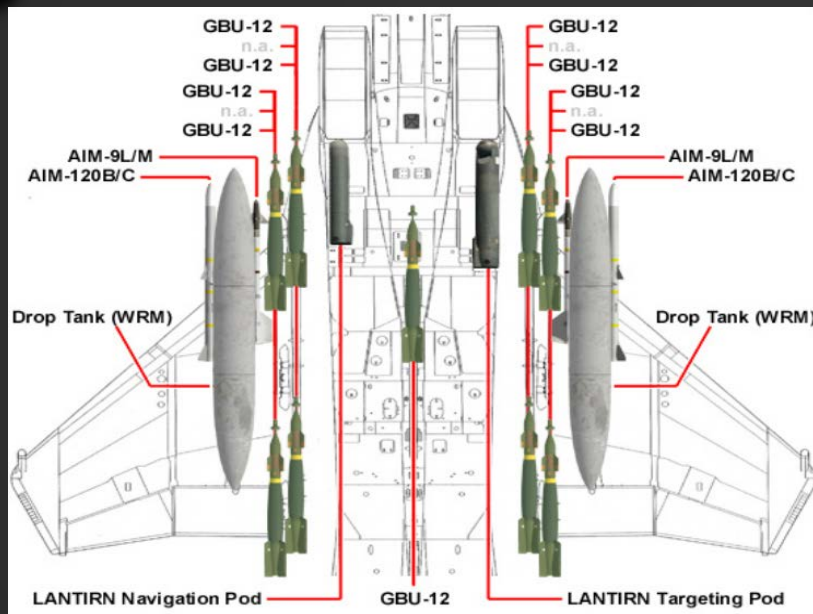

# ADDITIONAL INTELLIGENCE – ‘JUBA’ SNIPER

**WANTED**

## CONFIRMED INTELLIGENCE

**Capture or Kill Order**  
Authorization to Capture or  
Kill Juba

‘JUBA’ is the name used by a mysterious sniper or sniper(s) who targeted coalition personnel throughout Iraq in Operation Iraqi Freedom.

- US Intelligence believes Juba is actually made up of 2-4 snipers from Chechnya, and two of them are possibly brothers.
- US Intelligence reported Juba was killed in an airstrike in the city of Fallujah in 2005.
- Recent propaganda videos purportedly showing Juba killing Coalition Forces have been distributed online. The videos show Juba killing Coalition Forces inside the Georgian AOR. Voice match has confirmed the voice in recent videos is a match to previous videos produced inside Iraq.
- Within the last 60 days; Coalition Forces have taken 24 casualties from sniper fire in the Georgian AOR. 15 of the casualties have been recorded and distributed via social media.
- Intelligence suggest Juba will be operating in the Kutaisi AO within the next 12 hours.
- Additional security measures have been initiated in and around the Kutaisi AO.
- Whiplash-1 will authorize any force necessary to eliminate Juba if actionable intelligence is received on his / their locations within the AOR.



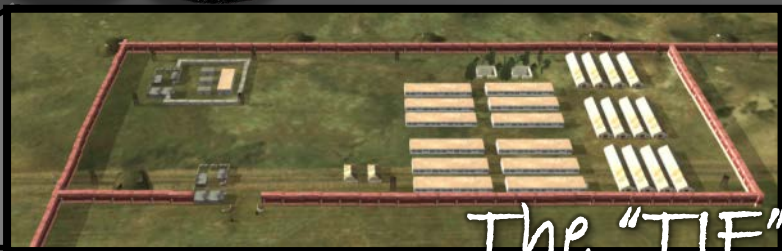
